

Report of the 5th meeting of Youth Policy Platform

November 11, 2019

Opportunities for new relationships at the national level were discussed today by participants in the Youth Policy Platform!

On November 11, the Platform gathered young people from various non-governmental organizations, various educational institutions and local authorities to discuss ideas and suggestions for building productive relations with the National Youth Council of Moldova (CNTM).

During the presentation, the obtained options for cooperation with the Council were discussed, as well as what tools and services may be useful to us. In addition, the participants proposed their contribution to the development of the Council - this is representing the opinion of the region and providing statistical information.

We separately discussed the possibility of developing the member organizations of the Platform in the prospect of joining the Council itself. So, being in the Platform can simplify the procedure for joining the association of youth organizations, as well as allow you to have access to many tools, trainings, materials, etc. for the development of organizations.

The representative of the executive authority of one of the settlements expressed his proposal on the participation of local authorities of representatives of mayoralities to attract investment, as the Platform can also participate as an applicant in partnership with the authorities.

In the near future, representatives of the Platform will meet with representatives of the National Council to discuss further cooperation.

It is important to note the interest of youth in long-term cooperation and information support of autonomy. This step will be a good contribution to the development of long-term relations between Gagauzia and Chisinau within the framework of the youth policy and promoting the interests of youth.

The amendment was also made for the yearbook, where at the end it should indicate the possibility of new organizations joining the Platform, as this publication will be widely distributed in Gagauzia, and the Platform can unite many stakeholders in the processes of lobbying and promoting youth policies.
